NATIONAL CORVETTE MUSEUM (NCM) AMBASSADOR

- Jerry Schlatter said they had a wonderful trip on the July 29 road tour sponsored by National Corvette Restorers Society (NCRS). Mike Mills from NCRS led the group which consisted of members from NCRS, GDCC, and Wright-Patterson AFB. The group ended the tour with dinner at the Montgomery Inn Barbecue on the river in Cincinnati.

- Jerry also mentioned a road trip to Bowling Green that Mike Mills and a few others did before they shut down the plant due to C7 production. They had a three hour plant tour.
- Jerry referenced an e-mail Mike sent to him about problems with the C6 fuel pump. When the fuel level drops below ¼ tank the fuel pump inside the tank is no longer submerged by gasoline to keep it cool. Although no duration was specified, prolonged exposure will cause the fuel pump to fail. If your car is still in the 36K/3 year bumper to bumper warranty, Chevrolet will not honor the warranty for fuel pump replacement. Corvette has examples of how these fuel pumps look when they fail from running a car with low fuel levels.
