He is involved with "Toys for Tots" program, Habitat for Humanity, the Wounded Warriors program and the Helmets to Hardhats programs. He also gives to worthwhile causes such as Honor Ride 2021 which provides escort services to WWII veterans to memorials and historic landmarks.
