The highest production year for Corvette was 1979, with 53,807 units produced. 2023 model year was next with 53,785 cars produced. The base model Corvette Sport Coupe for 1979 sold for \$10,220.

In 1979 the Corvette came in 10 colors: Classic White-8,692, Black-10,465, Light Blue- 3,203, Yellow- 2,357, Dark Green- 2,426, Light Beige-2,951, Red-6,707, Dark Brown-4,053 and Dark Blue-5,670.
